

4th Duke of Edinburgh Golf Tournament to benefit Christel House India

BENGALURU- The 4th Duke of Edinburgh Charity Golf Tournament will benefit Christel House India this year. Donors and sponsors will contribute to the school while competing in the 18-hole game at the Prestige Golfshire course in Bengaluru. Proceeds from the event will be donated to Christel House India, helping children break the cycle of poverty, realize their hopes and dreams, and become self-sufficient, contributing members of society.

The preliminary match is a one day event and will provide donors with networking opportunities, hole sponsorships, and partial fulfilment of their CSR obligations. The match is expected to raise \$25,000 for Christel House India. A team of two golfers with the best combined scores over the 18-hole preliminary game will represent Corporate India in the World Finals of the 4th Duke of Edinburgh Cup. The tournament finals will take place from September 27th to October 1st, and consist of a 36-hole match on two prestigious golf courses close to London. In addition, members of the Royal Family will host a match at their private golf course at Windsor castle, followed by a reception in the castle's State Apartments.
